CANVAS CARE

NORMAL CLEANING:

- 1. Brush off dust and dirt with a soft brush. NEVER brush with stiff brushes since this can damage the fabric finish.
- 2. Spray the canvas with clean water. If a hose is used, avoid high pressure.
- 3. Prepare a solution of solvent-free soap in warm water (no more than 100°F) and apply it on the fabric.
- 4. Scrub with a soft brush allowing the solution to penetrate the fabric.
- 5. Rinse with water to remove all traces of soap.
- 6. Let air dry, until the canvas is completely dry.

RECacril® is highly resistant to the growth of fungus, mold, and mildew; however, they can grow on embedded dirt. To clean these stains, follow these more intensive cleaning procedures:

INTENSIVE CLEANING:

- 1. Brush off dust and dirt with a soft brush. NEVER brush with stiff brushes since it could damage the finish and fabric.
- 2. Prepare a solution with 10% household bleach, 20% of solvent-free neutral detergent and 70% water.
- 3. Apply the solution on the fabric, allowing to remain between 15-20 minutes maximum.
- 4. Rinse with clean water several times. Bleach residues remaining on canvas combined with the sun could damage the fabric.
- 5. Allow to air dry, until the canvas is completely dry.
- 6. Repeat the process if necessary. To protect the environment, be sure to contain and dispose of the dirty water when using bleach as it can be harmful to animals and plants.
- **NOTE: Canvas will generally show crease lines. Please do not be alarmed, the lines will disappear in time as the canvas settles in the stretched position. **
